INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS AND PARTS LIST

APPLICATION: MODEL **571747** MEGA STEP BRACKETS ON: 2015+ GM 2500/3500HD PICKUPS, GAS/DIESEL

BODY MOUNT APPLICATION



NO DRILL APPLICATION

- 1. READ INSTRUCTIONS COMPLETELY AND CHECK TO MAKE SURE THAT ALL REQUIRED PARTS (LISTED ON SERVICE PARTS LIST) ARE ON HAND BEFORE STARTING THE INSTALLATION.
- 2. ON THE LEFT SIDE OF THE VEHICLE PREASSEMBLE THE FRONT BRACKET (ITEMS #2, 4) AS SHOWN IN FIG. 1 USING THREE 3/8"-16 X 1.0" SCREWS, 3/8" FLAT WASHER AND 3/8" FLANGE NUTS (TEMS #13, 19, 11). TORQUE TO 19 LB. FT. NOTE: IF INSTALLING ON A 1500 PICKUP YOU MUST ATTACH THE SMALL 90° BRACKET (ITEM #14) TO THE FRONT BRACKETS (SEE FIG 1.)
- 3. ASSEMBLE THE LOAD REACTION STUDS AND HARDWARE (ITEMS #10, 11, 12, 19) AS FOLLOWS.
 3.1. ON THE SHORT THREADED END OF THE LOAD REACTION STUD (ITEM #12), INSTALL A 3/8"
 SERRATED FLANGE NUT (ITEM #11) BACKWARDS TO THE BOTTTOM OF THE THREAD. THEN
 INSTALL A 3/8" FLAT WASHER (ITEM #19) AND RUBBER "CUSHION" WASHER (ITEM # 10)
 TIGHT UP AGAINST THE SERRATED FLANGE NUT. (THE END OF THE STUD MUST BE
 RECESSED IN THE RUBBER WASHER APPROX. 3/16").
 - 3.2. ON THE LONG THREADED END OF THE STUD, INSTALL A 3/8" SERRATED FLANGE NUT (ITEM #11) BACKWARDS TO NEAR TO THE BOTTTOM OF THE THREADS
- 4. ATTACH THE LOAD REACTION STUD ASSEMBLIES TO THE MOUNTING BRACKETS AS SHOWN IN **FIG. 4**. INSERT THE STUD, FROM WHAT WILL BE THE INBOARD OR FRAME SIDE THRU THE LOWEST HOLE IN THE BENT FLANGE OF THE BRACKET THAT WILL ALLOW THE RUBBER WASHER TO SEAT FIRM AGAINST THE SIDE WALL OF THE FRAME. INSTALL A 3/8" SERRATED FLANGE NUT (ITEM #11) ON THE OUTBOARD END OF THE STUD (FINGER TIGHT ONLY).

NOTE:

DUE TO EXCESSIVE THREAD LOCKER IN THE BODY MOUNT BOLT AREA ON THE 2010+ GM SILVERADO/SIERRA, USE CAUTION WHEN REMOVING THE BODY MOUNT BOLTS.

- 5. REMOVE THE FACTORY FRONT, CENTER, AND REAR BODY MOUNT BOLTS AND INSTALL THE MOUNTING BRACKETS PER THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS:
 - 5.1. INSTALL THE FRONT MOUNTING BRACKET (ITEMS #2, 4) TO THE FRONT BODY MOUNT AS SHOWN (LEAVE THESE FASTENERS FINGER TIGHT).
 - 5.2. INSTALL THE CENTER MOUNTING BRACKET (ITEM #5) TO THE CENTER BODY MOUNT AS SHOWN (LEAVE THESE FASTENERS FINGER TIGHT).
 - 5.3. INSTALL THE REAR MOUNTING BRACKET (ITEM #9) & WASHER (ITEM #15) TO THE REAR BODY MOUNT AS SHOWN (LEAVE THESE FASTENERS FINGER TIGHT).
 - 5.4. ATTACH THE REAR OUTBOARD MTG BRKT (ITEM #7) TO THE REAR INBOARD MTG BRKT (ITEM #9), USING THREE 3/8"-16 X 1.0" SCREWS, 3/8" FLAT WASHERS AND 3/8" FLANGE NUTS. (ITEMS #13, 19, 11). THE REAR OUTBOARD MOUNTING BRACKET MUST BE MOUNTED TO THE BACK SIDE OF THE REAR INBOARD MOUNTING BRACKET (TOWARDS THE REAR OF THE VEHICLE) AS SHOWN IN FIG 2 AND 3. BE SURE TO USE THE CORRECT HOLES AS SHOWN IN FIG. 2 & 3. NOTE THAT THERE IS A DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE DOUBLE CAB AND CREW CAB APPLICATIONS. TORQUE THE BOLTS TO 19 LB. FT.



- 6. ATTACH THE SPRING HANGER MOUNTING BRACKETS (ITEM# 16, 17) AGAINST THE SIDE OF THE VEHICLE SPRING HANGER AS SHOWN.
 - 6.1 LOOSEN THE SPRING HANGER BOLT JUST ENOUGH SO THAT THE INBOARD SPRING HANGER MOUNTINGG BRACKET (ITEM #16) CAN BE SLID UP BEHIND THE FLANGE OF THE BOLT. POSITION THE INBOARD SPRING HANGER MOUNTING BRACKET BEHIND THE FLANGE OF THE SPRING HANGER BOLT, WITH THE CHANNEL OPEN TO THE OUTBOARD SIDE, AS SHOWN.
 - 6.2 USING A 3/8"-16 BOLT, 3/8" WASHER, 1/2" WASHER AND 3/8" LOCK NUT (ITEMS# 19-21) INSTALL THE OUTBOARD SPRING HANGER MOUNTING BRACKET (ITEM #17) SO THAT THE INBOARD VERTICAL PORTION OF THE BRACKET FITS INSIDE THE CHANNEL SHAPE OF THE INBOARD SPRING HANGER BRACKET. LEAVE THESE FASTENERS FINGER TIGHT AT THIS TIME.
- 7. INSTALL THE STEP BOARDS AS DESCRIBED BY THE INSTRUCTIONS INCLUDED WITH YOUR STEP BOARDS. (NOTE: INSURE THAT THE MOUNTING BRACKETS DO NOT TOUCH THE INSIDE WALL OF THE BODY MOUNT HOUSING AND TORQUE THE BODY MOUNT FASTENERS TO MANUFACTURES SPECS).
- 8. POSITION THE LOAD REACTION BOLT ASSEMBLY SO THAT THE RUBBER CUSHION IS SNUG UP AGAINST THE SIDE OF THE FRAME. TIGHTEN THE 3/8" FLANGE NUTS ON EITHER SIDE OF THE BRKT TO 19LB. FT.
- 9. REPEAT STEPS 1-7 FOR THE RIGHT SIDE OF THE VEHICLE.



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

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REAR BRACKET ASSEMBLY DOUBLE CAB




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CREW CAB REAR BRACKET ASSEMBLY





