



**INSTALLATION** (For ease of installation it is suggested that the wheel be removed)


- 1. Remove the 5 factory screws from the existing factory guard.
- 2. Gently pull the guard from the truck.
- 3. Position cap, ensuring the top lip of the cap slides under the fender molding.
- 4. Install the finishing cap to the factory holes using supplied screws and washers. Be careful not to overtighten.
- 5. Repeat procedure on passenger side.

## FINISHING CAPS FC004R:






**INSTALLATION** (For ease of installation it is suggested that the wheel be removed)

## CAPS:

- 1. Remove the 5 factory screws from the existing factory guard.
- 2. Gently pull the guard from the truck.
- 3. Position cap, ensuring the top lip of the cap slides under the fender molding as shown.
- 4. Install the underside and back of the finishing cap to the factory holes using a screw (g) and flat washer (h). Be careful not to overtighten.
- 5. Repeat procedure on passenger side.



\*Universal Instructions: Diagram of parts may vary due to application differences.



## MUD FLAPS:

- 1. Before you install your Mud Flap Set, see the diagram and parts list for all necessary parts. Start on the driver's side.
- 2. Loosely install mount clip (e) to mud flap holes #1 & #2 using a cap screw (a) and flat washer (d)
- 3. Loosely secure mud flap hole #3 to finishing cap hole #6 using screw (b) and flat washer (c)
- 4. Secure mount clips (e) on holes #1 & #2 behind fender lip. \*Note\* Ensure all factory holes line up with finishing cap holes.
- 5. Secure mud flap through holes #4 & #5 into finishing cap hole #7 & #8 using supplied screw (b), and washer (c).
- 6. Using a bubble level or other levelling tool, ensure that the mud flap is level. Tighten fasteners, being careful not to overtighten.
- 7. Repeat procedure for passenger side.
